Jens Jensen immigrated from Denmark to America as a young man, and became the father of Landscape Architecture, mastering the use of native plants. He built numerous parks from Chicago to the Door Peninsula, Jensen inspired generations of designers. He died in 1951 at his beloved folk school The Clearing in Ellison Bay, Wisconsin.

Roger Kuhns is a long-time practitioner of Jensen's innovative and sustainable land use and design methods. He brings to the stage the very human side of Jensen through his stories, philosophy and humor to reconnect people to the importance of Jensen's work.
